



Purpose and Object:

As part of the ongoing responsibility of the Church to nurture believers and train future leaders in the faith, we are excited to offer the Christian Discipleship Institute as an educational and training opportunity. Program Requirements:

- Ten six-week courses over 20 months: seven core courses plus three specialized courses. Each course involves:
 - * six ninety-minute class sessions
 - * some writing assignments
- Resources: course notebook, textbook(s), faithful class attendance and pre-class preparation
- A possible eight-week practicum period will be explored.
